If a diabetic patient is scheduled for an exam involving x-ray contrast for a CT or IVP, please be advised:

If you take glucophage, metformin, glucovance, avadamet it is important that you do not take these medications for 24 hours prior to and 48 hours after your examination. The combination of CT contrast and these prescription medications have the potential to cause serious side effects. If you have any questions, please call your doctor for more information.
